Youth Care Worker Requirements:

- 21 years of age.
- High school diploma or equivalent. (Preference and salary adjustment for those possessing or in pursuit of a bachelor's degree.)

- A pre-employment background check as well as a physical exam and drug test will be required, including a TB test.
